Dear Mr. Leibovich:

I am writing with regard to your recent e-mail, to Robert Redford's office here at Wildwood Enterprises, Inc.

On behalf of Mr. Redford, thank you for your kind consideration of him for a possible cameo role in your upcoming film, *Outlaws of the Patagonia*.

While the description of the film project as well as your unique invitation were certainly engaging, Mr. Redford will be unable to participate. On a creative level, "Sundance" was and remains such a meaningful role in his career that he has no plans to revisit it in any additional films featuring those characters. Additionally, his current film production and/or development schedule (as an actor and/or producer) and calendar of organizational and business commitments precludes further undertakings at present.

The simple fact is that *Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid* was such a special film for him, and to so many of those involved in its creation, that attempting to re-inhabit that particular character to recapture or further the essence of that tale in a new film is not something he is keen to do. Though your thoughtfulness was very much appreciated, we do hope for your understanding.

As you continue your work, please know that Mr. Redford will continue to support and further independent cinema and the arts through his ongoing work with the non-profit Sundance Institute (www.sundance.org). Perhaps one or more of their programs may be of interest to you for future projects; particularly the Sundance/NHK International Filmmakers Award which presents long term support to one Latin American Filmmaker annually.

Thank you once again for thinking of Mr. Redford for this and best wishes for an enjoyable and successful film production!
